Transitional Kindergarten is designed for students who are not quite ready for Kindergarten or who narrowly miss the cutoff for Kindergarten. Students entering TK should know the majority of their letter sounds and be prepared to take the next step toward emergent reading.

Students will participate in multiple subject areas including reading, math, STEAM, and social skills. Additionally, they will continue to have Bible and music.

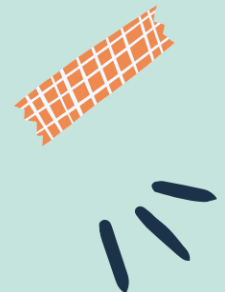
